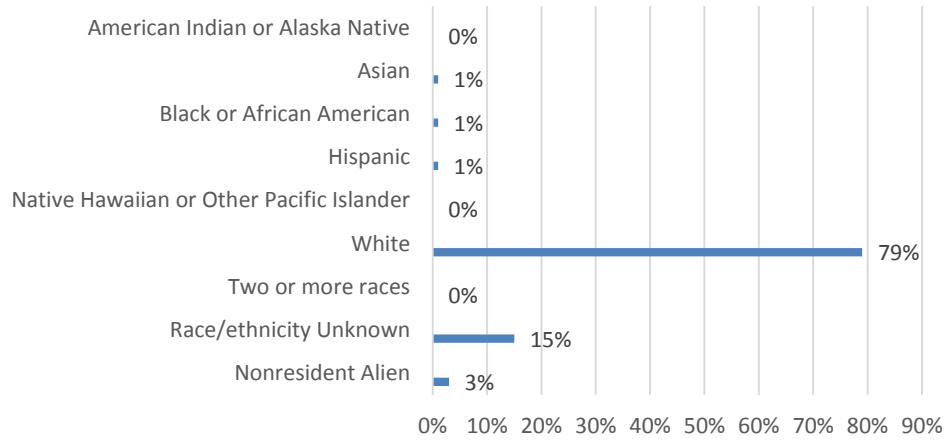

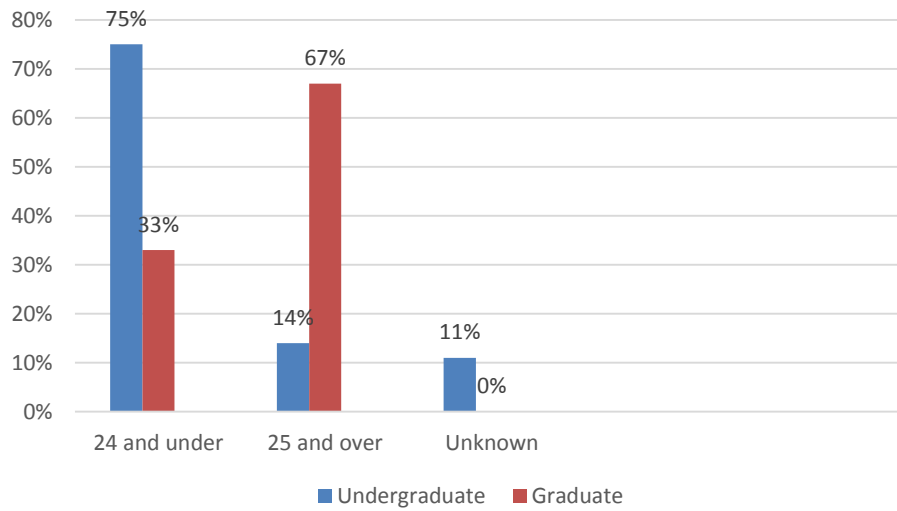

Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2017

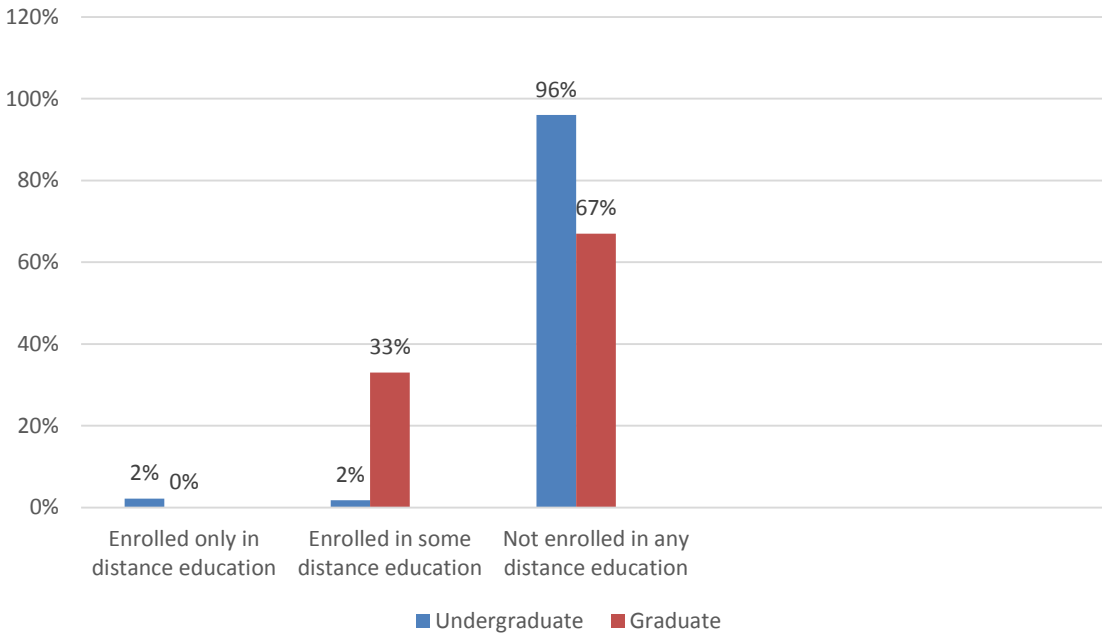


Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2017



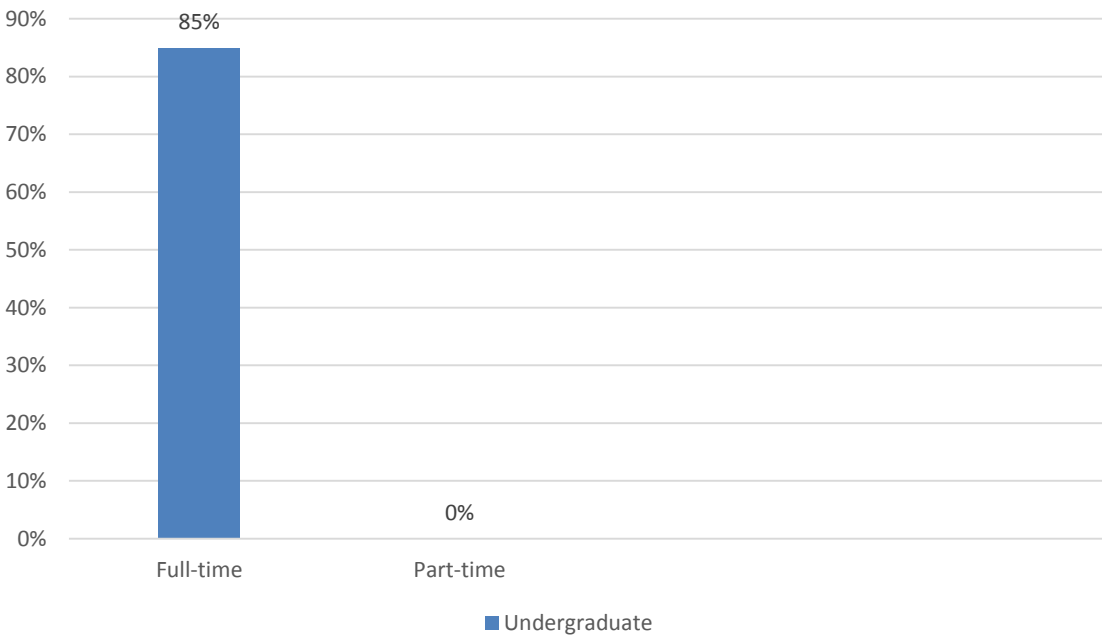

Enrollment by distance education: Fall 2017



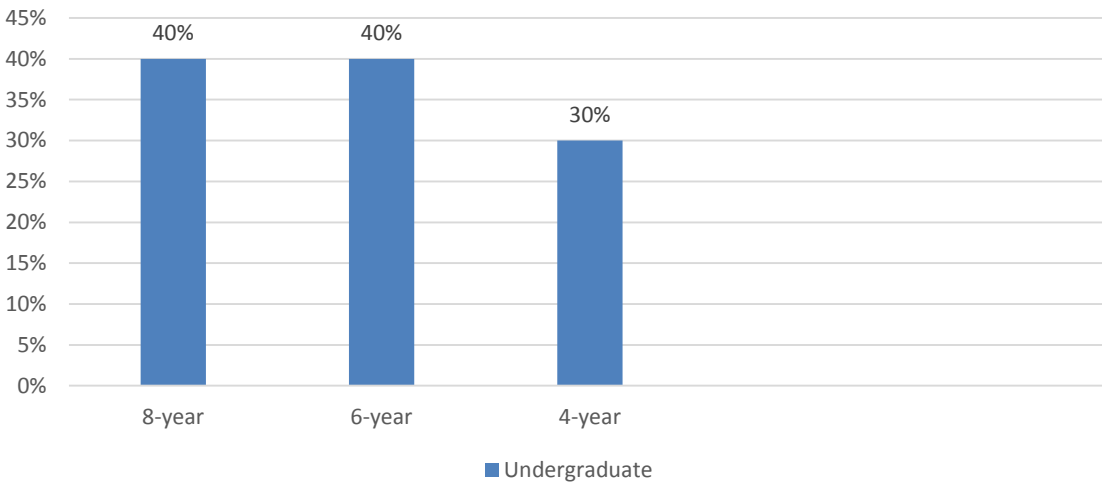
